

Sunday School for elementary aged children:


9:30-10:45 - "Record Setters" Children will study various stories from the Bible in which something extraordinary happened - Jesus being resurrected from the grave, David defeating Goliath, and the extravagant love of the woman who anointed Jesus, to name a few. Children will be challenged to expect BIG things from God in their lives and to be bold in Christ.

We teach in a large group/small group format; we begin with worship and the Bible lesson in large group, then children are dismissed to small groups divided by grade/age to do activities such as games, crafts, Scripture memorization, or prayers to further understand how our lesson applies to their day to day lives.

11:00-11:15 - Children are brought to the sanctuary to participate in the opening worship songs, prayers, and other aspects of the service. Children are encouraged to come and participate in a children's sermon time, and following that, are welcome to sit with their parents or guardians for the remainder of the worship service time, or they are welcome to go back to children's area with Ms. Alicia.

11:15 - Noon - we will focus again on the lesson God is teaching us through the Bible story that was taught in the first hour. We will typically watch a short video to demonstrate the message, and participate in more activities which help the children understand the importance of living faithfully with God as their focus

Elementary children's Sunday school is for children ages kindergarten through 4th grade. We do have a special needs ministry that is available upon request to help children with special needs during services.

Value: \$12.00 per kit

Hygiene Kit Materials

- One hand towel (15 x 25 –17 x 27 inches)
 - No kitchen, cleaning, or microfiber towels
- One washcloth
- One comb
 - o Must be sturdy with at least 6 inches of teeth
 - No pocket combs or picks
 - Ratiail and combs without handles are acceptable but must have at least 6 inches of teeth
 - One toenail or fingernail clipper
 - No emery boards or metal nail files
- Bath-size soap (3 oz. bar or larger)
 - No lvory or Jergen's soap
 Do not remove from packaging
- One adult toothbrush
 - Do not remove from packaging
 - Personal advertising not acceptable
- 10 adhesive bandages (¾ by 3 inches)
 Common household bandages acceptable
- One one-gallon size re-sealable bag

Important Notes

- · All items must be new.
- · Do not wash any of the items, as they will no longer be considered new.
- · Do not include any personal notes, money or additional materials in the kits.
- Contents of kits or the containers of kits should not be imprinted with cartoon characters, advertisements, religious, patriotic, military or camouflage symbols
