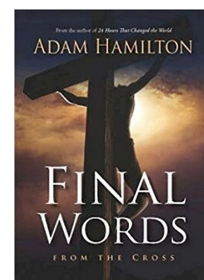


Final Words: From the Cross by Adam Hamilton

Those with last names beginning A– G, please bring a dessert. There is no charge for the meal.

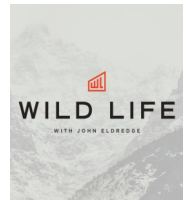

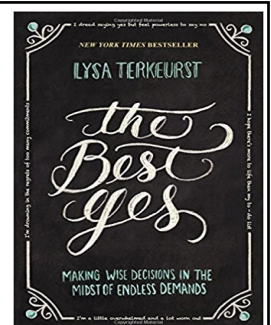
Sweets for the Sweet

Church Council Notes

Church Council met on Tuesday, January 30, 2018. Here is what happened:

Review of minutes and approval

Discussion of volunteer ministry allocation pie chart (also passed out in worship) and how it is helping to understand who we are. This led into discussion of some of the dreams and visions of the church as we seek to follow Christ. Small groups may be one key opportunity for achieving goals.

Discussion of safety concerns at church in light of recent developments. Two key areas: 1) natural disaster (particularly tornado) and 2) active shooters. Council reviewed current safeguards. The policy will be reviewed and revisited next meeting.

Discussion on 2018 budget. Council spent time looking over past years directions, pledges, line by line expenses, apportionments and long term expenses on horizon. Budget of \$590,255. was approved. It will be a challenge for each of us as we go through this year. Bottom line of Council was that "It's gonna work out by Faith!"

A proposal to update lights throughout the church was made to Council by Trustees. The cost should be met in savings in 1 to 1 1/2 years with long term savings being significant.

There was discussion about plans for Lent and Easter. 2-3 Lenten studies and other activities will be taking place between Ash Wednesday (February 15) and Easter (April 1).
