St. Mark's votes in Special Called Church Conference to disaffiliate from United Methodist Church

This past Sunday at the church conference St. Mark's voted to disaffiliate from the United Methodist Church. The final vote was 158 to disaffiliate; 10 not to disaffiliate; and 3 Abstentions. This came to a 92% majority which surpassed the 66.7% majority vote needed.

So what is the next step? More importantly, things at St. Mark's will continue to look the same and we will continue to follow Christ. The church council will be hard at work taking all the steps necessary to complete the paperwork needed for disaffiliation. When the Annual Conference meets on October 20-21, they will vote to allow us to disaffiliate. Over the next few weeks we encourage all members to be in prayer for the church, its people and leaders, the United Methodist Church and for God's presence in the midst of the transition.

Our transition team is available to you if you have any questions about the process we are in the midst of our transition to disaffiliation. Feel free to contact any of them with anything dealing with our disaffiliation. We want St. Mark's to be a place where all feel loved and accepted.
