Worship at St. Mark's, August 29

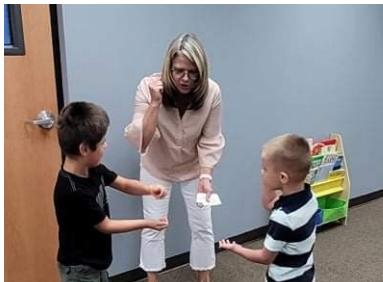
We invite everyone to come out this coming Sunday to join us in worship. Services are @ 9:30 (Classic) and 10:55 (Modern).

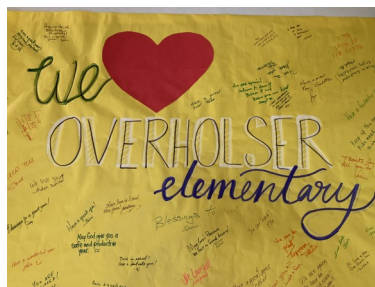

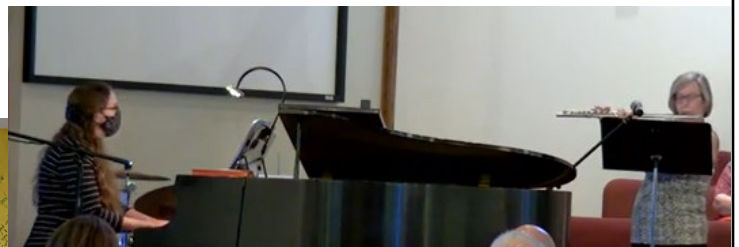

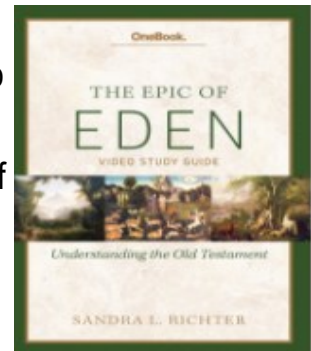
Wednesday Programming to return September 8th

New Class starting September 8th Understanding the Old Testament

Nancy Johnson will lead a new class kicking off at 6:30 pm on September 8th. You can sign up on church counter or call church office. A quick summary of the study: Does your knowledge of the Old Testament feel like a grab bag of people, books, events and ideas? How many times have you resolved to really understand the OT? To finally make sense of it? In *The Epic of Eden Video Study*, Dr. Sandra Richter clearly and powerfully communicates a history of God's redeeming grace, weaving together a story that runs from the Eden of the Garden to the garden of the New Jerusalem.

Through text and video teaching, Dr. Richter uses this 12-week study to bring a new dimension to the history of the ancient Near East, orienting any study group in time, geography, culture, redemption, and relevance to today — all without diminishing her reader's faith or dumbing down the scripture.
