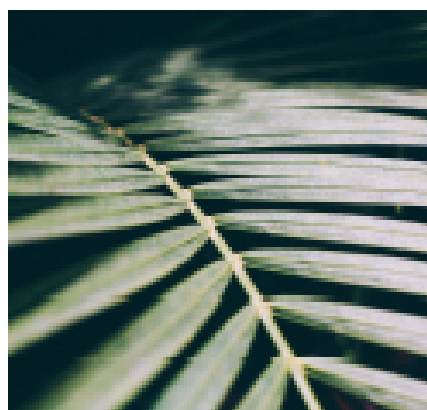

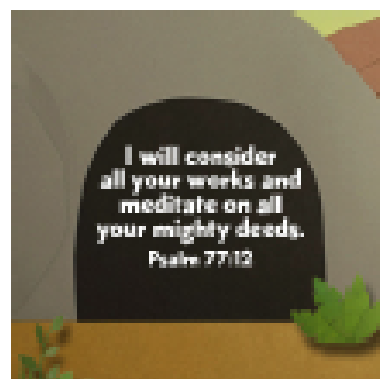

### Waving of the Palms

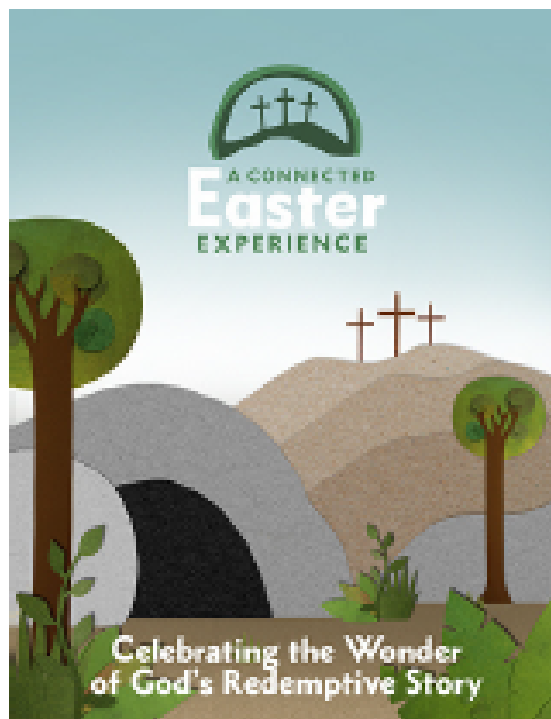
Children will be waving the Palms in both services, so please arrive by 9:30 am so we can get children ready into place. All children will participate including our youngest.

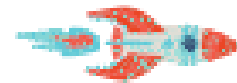
