
## Women's Bible Study






There will be three different opportunities this Lenten season to be a part of a Bible Study. The studies include Lee

## Pancake Breakfast Boy Scout Troop 553


February 9, 7:00 am - 11:00 am Come out and support our troop. They will

door.



Sunday School for elementary aged children:

9:30-10:45 "Extreme" – studying Bible events that are extreme - extremely hard to believe in many instances. We will study a series of events from the Old Testament and New Testament that will guide us to learn that God's love is extreme for us. God goes to great lengths to reach us, love us, and guide us. A few extreme events we will study are: Saul's Road to Damascus, Elijah and the chariots of fire, Jesus' temptation, and the extreme love of Jesus to go to the cross for us. Memory verse for this unit is 1 Corinthians 2:9 "It is written that no eye has seen, no ear has heard, and no human mind has known. God has prepared these things for those who love him."

11:00-11:15 - Children are brought to the sanctuary to participate in the opening worship songs, prayers, and other aspects of the service. Children are encouraged to come and participate in a children's sermon time, and following that, are welcome to sit with their parents or guardians for the remainder of the worship service time, or they are welcome to go back to children's area with Ms. Alicia.

11:15 - Noon - we will focus again on the lesson God is teaching us through the Bible story that was taught in the first hour. We will typically watch a short video to demonstrate the message, and participate in more activities which help the children understand the importance of living faithfully with God as their focus.

Elementary children's Sunday school is for children ages 1st grade through 5th grade. We do have a special needs ministry that is available upon request to help children with special needs during services.
