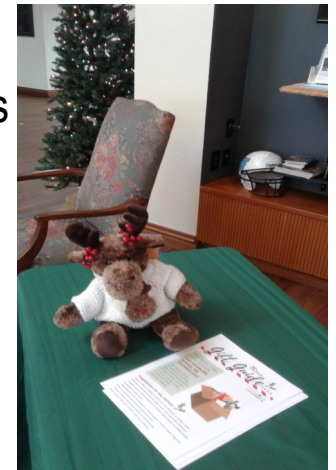
2020 Report on Care Share with Overholser

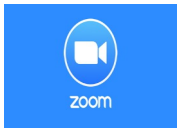
