SUNDAY MORNING:

Age Nursery - Kindergarten Time 9:30 am - 12:00 pm Age Kindergarten - 4th grade Time: 9:30 am - 12:00 pm

Beginning January 7, elementary children will be studying EPIPHANY - the unveiling of the incarnate Jesus Christ. We will be exploring different events from the life of Jesus, along with his promise to return again as clues to what our One True God is like and what he has in mind for his people - us.

January 14: Named/Adopted/Identified through baptism

Children ages Kindergarten through 4th grade are invited to attend Sunday school from 9:30-Noon.
