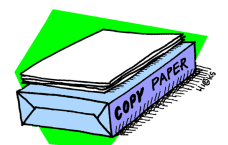

Experiment with types and ways of praying that are described in Scripture.

Encourage each other to keep striving toward growth goals previously set by the group and individuals.

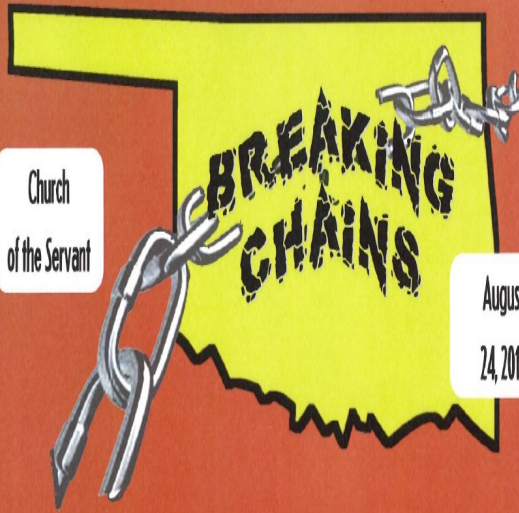
Looking forward to seeing you all at our final summer events and I'm excited for what the fall will bring for our ministry. Praying for you all! Please, let me know if I can help you in any way!
