I am so excited for fall programming! This past Wednesday, we had a great time playing games and shooting the STRIVE announcement video. This Wednesday we're kicking off our first series of the fall (and my first series ever as a youth pastor)!

#### Wednesday, Sept. 12

D.O.W.N. (Dinner on Wednesday Nights) is at 5:30, \$3/person and Youth is from 6:15-7:30. **We are beginning a series called Untitled**. We'll talk about some of the misconceptions we have about God and we'll learn to replace those with the truth of who He actually is.

Sunday, Sept. 16

Sunday School is at 9:45 and big church is at 10:55!

**METRO WORSHIP** is Sunday evening! We're going out to dinner beforehand and then we're heading to St. Luke's for a worship time with other youth groups from the metro area. This is a great time to build community, see old camp friends, and worship God in a different setting. Meet at the church at 4:45 and we'll be back about 8.

#### JU signup is happening now!

With Jesus University, students have the opportunity from 6th-12th grade to earn scholarship money, which can be used after graduation for continuing education. They earn money based on their participation in camps, mission trips, and retreats. Sunday morning attendance is vital, as the majority of JU credit comes from attending regularly. STRIVE is mandatory, because that's where JU funds come from. To be a part of JU for this school year, **sign up no later than Sunday, Sept. 16!** There is a *\$20/person enrollment fee*.

I strongly encourage everyone to sign up for JU, because I, as well as many others who graduated from St. Mark's student ministries, have benefited greatly from this program. It's well worth it. Also, students who sign up get a t-shirt, which is always fun.

#### STRIVE begins on Sept. 19!

STRIVE is our ministry's annual fundraiser. The earnings go towards camps, retreats, mission trips, and the JU fund. Students ask people to donate, and as a thank you, the students will serve for 8 hours on the STRIVE workday.

The **STRIVE workday is Oct. 13** and it is <u>mandatory</u> for those who participated in the STRIVE fundraiser. Others who didn't participate in the STRIVE fundraiser are also more than welcome to join us for this service day!

STRIVE has been the student ministry fundraiser at St. Mark's for nearly two decades, and our church family has been extremely generous over the years. STRIVE is an incredible opportunity for our students to meet people in our church and to experience perhaps the easiest fundraiser they will ever participate in. I know some of our students are shy about asking for money, but they can feel much better knowing that **our St. Mark's family really** *wants* **to give!** 


Also, those who do STRIVE get a t-shirt. So if you sign up for JU and STRIVE, that's two t-shirts. It doesn't get much better than that.

## Sign Up for Adult Studies available this fall


