






Second Winders will meet Thursday, December 12th.




Christmas Eve Offering Set

The over 1/2 will go to YFS (Youth & Family Services) in El Reno to update some of their furnishings creating a loving environment for children and families who have been displaced and have need for safety, security, food and shelter. We are excited to part-



ner with both of these ministries who are reaching out locally and around the world to make a real difference in the lives of people.

Kenya Mission Trip Team Forming for Trip August 1-11, 2020

Mark and Kinsey serve in central Kenya where they are active with a pizza & coffee shop, the One World Cafe', in the town of Nyahururu. Mark is currently working with area officials

to develop plans for drilling wells that will provide clean water for area residents, like the one we funded in Magomano, and the Foglemans are active in discipleship and missionary training with a local organization called God's Grace for All Nations. Team members will be doing some combination of assisting with a VBS at the Children's Home, working on the Magomano Water Project, helping with the Cafe' and training residents in biblical or business issues.
