



# Capital Campaign Update from Pastor Randy

At the end of each month, we will be updating everyone on the progress of our capital campaign at the end of both worship services and in the Newsletter.

Taking Root: A Place to Grow, is off to a great start. We began the month of April having received \$595,455 and will end the month with \$635,404. This is wonderful! Since we committed to only spend money as it comes in, the sooner it comes in the sooner we can begin work on our various projects. Thank you for your generous support.

While there is no construction or refurbishment going on at the moment, that doesn't mean we aren't making progress. Our architect and construction team have been meeting to hammer out the details of the work in the Family Life Center, Barnett Hall and the main bathrooms. We have been in contact with the roofer who will be recovering part of our roof and look to get that started once storm season is over. We have teams meeting to begin working out the details in the children's area and sanctuary and we have already gotten some prices on repairs to the parking lots. Nearly every area of our church will be getting major upgrades over the next three years and getting all of these projects done with minimal impact to our existing ministries will be a challenge. So we ask for your continued prayers and patience as we work through the order and details of each project.




