We are thrilled to share joyful news: all of our seventh-grade students (63 students) passed the Tanzania National Examination! 52 students passed with A grade and 11 passed with B grade. This is a wonderful achievement for them and for our school.

The Need for the School Lunch Program

At the same time, we want to highlight a very important need that remains close to our hearts - the School Lunch Program. Many children cannot learn well when they are hungry. A simple lunch can change a child's whole day.

To those who already support this program, we say a heartfelt *thank you*. Your generosity helps us feed students who might otherwise go without a meal. Because of you, children are smiling more, learning better, and dreaming bigger. You are giving them hope for a brighter tomorrow, and we are deeply grateful.

Our goal is simple but powerful: to provide lunch for every student at our school. We are moving toward this dream, but we cannot reach it alone. We still need friends and partners who can sponsor a student's lunch. Just \$ 100 can feed one child for an entire month. Your gift can change a life.



We also want to share that all 51 students who receive sponsorship are doing very well academically. Their minds are growing and their dreams are becoming brighter because of your generosity.

Among these 51 sponsored students, there twelve high school students and eight of them are Maasai girls. We are especially grateful for the opportunity to support them. In many Maasai communities, girls often face great challenges when it comes to education. By giving them the chance to learn, you are helping to break cycles of poverty, early marriage, and limited opportunities. When you empower a girl with education, you empower a family, a community, and a future generation.

Thank you, dear sponsors, for believing in these students. Thank you for giving them hope, courage, and the chance to dream. Because of you, they walk into the classroom each day with confidence. Because of you, their lives are being transformed.
