Through your prayers, service and generosity, we are able to partner with these organizations as they share hope, meet practical needs, and reflect Christ's love in meaningful ways.



This event is sponsored by the Kings & Queens Ministry and serves as a fundraiser to support their ministry, so come hungry and help make a difference -- one bowl at a time.


Who will be the winners this year?


Please keep this mission opportunity in your prayers, and ask God whether He might be calling you to be part of this meaningful journey.

Youth Winter Retreat 2026 – Sign Up Now!






