If you are not able to attend there will be a live streaming of worship. To watch the life stream, you can join us at 9:30 am Sunday morning at:











New Adult Bible Studies in 2022


Sunday Mornings



New Adult Study Wednesday Evening Feb. 9th 6:15-7:30pm


Wondering How to Defend your Faith in today's World?
