### Hello St Markians!

St. Mark's is moving forward, inch by inch, with more **in-person gatherings**. **Sunday morning worship** attendance has come close to filling the sanctuary at our new capacity (50'ish) the past weeks. **Online attendance** remains strong and the geographic scope of our outreach online is broad. Many online **small groups**, studies and Life groups are meeting online.

**The food pantry** has been operating through this entire time. The number of families served increased and has decreased some now that people are returning to work. Thank you for all your food donations. **Mark'd Kids and CDO** are going well on Tuesdays and Thursdays. **Pop-up church** for the children in meeting on the east lawn Wednesday evenings. **Student Ministry** will begin meeting again on Wednesdays soon. One **Sunday school class** meets before worship service in the west parking lot. A few activities are meeting at the church throughout the week. Official **church open hours** are 8-3:30 on Tuesday and Thursdays. **Worship teams** and partial **choir** are providing music online and live. **Scouts** may start again as early as August. It is a long way from normal, but St Markians are getting together in-person more frequently...and carefully.

The **Re-Opening Team**, led by David Miller, is doing the careful task of guiding the opening process. CDC, State, WHO and denominational guidelines are being followed the best we can. **Sunday School classes** are welcome to meet at the church at times other than Sunday morning. I know that is odd, but it is a way to help keep safe distances and clean rooms for the meetings. Given safe distancing, a room such as room 18 for instance, only holds about 12 individuals or 10 pairs of people. And of course, face masks need to be worn inside. Once a room is used, it needs to be disinfected before the next group may use it.

**Making reservations** for rooms and lawn space is crucial. So if your group wants to meet, please reserve a place inside or out through Pat Morford. Don't you appreciate the **daily devotions**?! Thank you to everyone who is sharing!

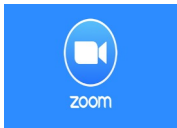

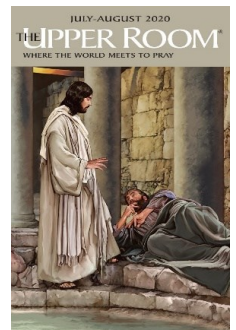

If your health self-assessment indicates that none of the above symptoms or situations apply to you or anyone in you party, then go ahead and make a reservation to attend worship.
