If your health self-assessment indicates that none of the above symptoms or situations apply to you or anyone in you party, then go ahead and make a reservation to attend worship and include any children attending also.

To make your reservation, reply to worship@stmarksbethany.com and include your name, the names of all those attending with you and the total number of people in your party.

You will receive a confirmation email that will give more details about the service. If the capacity limit has been reached you will receive an email letting you know and inviting you to attend online.


