

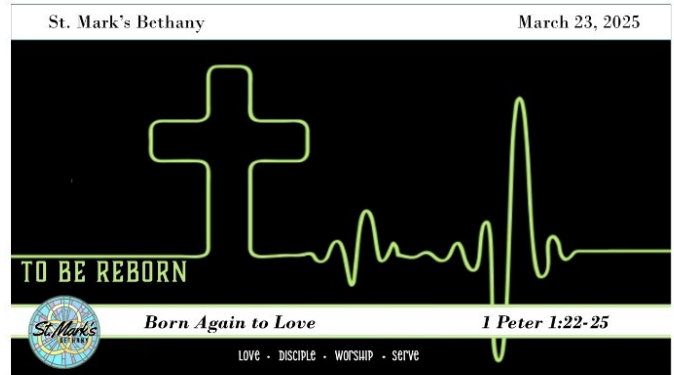


ST. MARK'S BETHANY NEWSLETTER

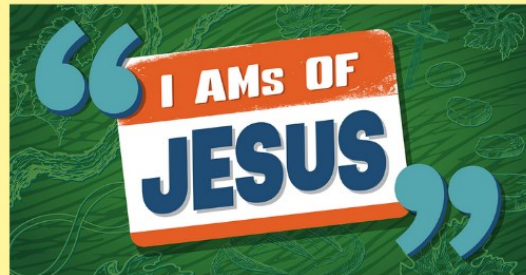

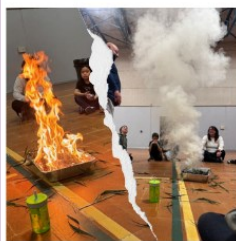

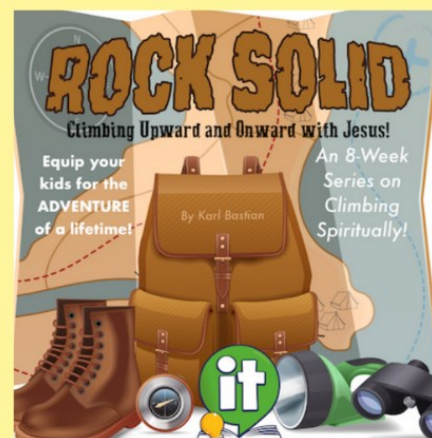


Connect Lent @ Home
