She is seeing some improvement although she still can't lift her leg. Surgeon says it may take a year before the femoral nerve can retrack. She is still unable to transfer herself from the bed to her wheelchair, but she is progressing toward that. Please continue to pray that one day she will be able to do this on her own.

Judy McMinn – Judy's PT reminded her this week that nerve damage is hard to treat, and that is why the process and progress are so slow. Please continue to pray that the therapist stays positive and helps Judy keep a positive attitude also and continues to work toward walking.
